Co-authors who do not have a PhD share their score according to their participation in a statement (see below).

Publications related to the research topic must have **at least 50 credits**. In the evaluation of publishing activities, only the data appearing in the official collection of the Hungarian scientific works (MTMT) can be taken into account as follows:

Proofreaded journals

IF: 24 credits

Without IF, published abroad: 16 credits

Without IF, published in Hungary: 12 credits

Proofreaded conference paper (min. 4 pages) in an ISBN numbered in printed or electronic form

Publications related to the research topic must have **at least 75 credits**. In the evaluation of publishing activities, only the data appearing in the official collection of the Hungarian scientific works (MTMT) can be taken into account as follows:

Scientific article

Proofreaded journals

IF: 36 credits

Without IF, published abroad: 24 credits

Without IF, published in Hungary: 18 credits

Proofreaded conference paper (min. 4 pages) in an ISBN numbered in printed or electronic form

in a foreign language 24

in Hungarian 6

Scientific book or booktype

in a foreign language: 3,6 credit/20 pages

in Hungarian: 1.8 credit/20 pages





PUBLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Minimum standards for publishing when submitting the dissertation

For each thesis in the dissertation, it is necessary to specify where the candidate has published the results. At least half of the thesis points should be related to journals or conference papers.

For co-authored publications, co-authors who do not have a PhD degree must provide the "Co-author statement" (see below). In this statement, the co-authors who do not have a PhD degree agree on the extent to which their participation percentage in the scientific work in question. This statement must be made once when that publication is first used in a rating process and each co-author should keep a copy for the subsequent rating process to be initiated.

At least two of the scientific papers related to the thesis points in which the Nominee had to appear, at least 50% co-authored on the basis of this statement, in a journal with an impact factor on the Web of Science or Scopus list.

It is also a minimum requirement that the Candidate will confirm at least one conference presentation.
