

H3) Structure of the habilitation thesis

The purpose of the thesis booklet is to provide a concise overview of the applicant's continuous scientific and creative activities since obtaining their doctoral (PhD/DLA) degree and the scientific results they have achieved. The thesis booklet is only based on a dissertation in certain cases, so it must be understandable and assessable on its own. Concepts, acronyms, and abbreviations must be defined in the thesis booklet. For concepts that are not or not sufficiently established in the Hungarian language, the corresponding foreign language expression must be given in parentheses.

The thesis booklet must not exceed 50 pages (A5 format, 2.5 cm margins, 12 pt Times New Roman – or equivalent – font size, double spacing).

The thesis booklet must follow the following content structure:

I. BACKGROUND OF THE RESEARCH

Description of the research topic, brief overview of the literature, connection to previous results in the field.

II. NEW SCIENTIFIC RESULTS

Description of the specific scientific results achieved by the applicant, summarized in thesis points. Each thesis point must refer to the relevant publication(s).

If there are references to other authors, they should be cited using the [name, year] format, while the applicant's own publications related to the thesis points should be cited using the serial number format.

III. IMPACT AND RESONANCE OF THE RESEARCH AND PRESENTED RESULTS

A brief textual presentation of other domestic and international research inspired by the applicant's scientific research results, as well as references to publications containing the results.

IV. LIST OF REFERENCES

References to the literature used, published by other authors [name, year].

V. SCIENTIFIC PUBLICATIONS RELATED TO THE THESIS POINTS

Numbered list indicating the authors, title, and place of publication. Only publications referred to by the candidate in the thesis points may be included in the list.

VI. ADDITIONAL SCIENTIFIC PUBLICATIONS (OPTIONAL)

List of additional publications by the candidate, numbered consecutively.
